### What we did this week:

This week the children have continued to learn about the animals with enthusiasm! They love naming the animals!

In English, the children have made a GIANT octopus with eight long legs, which we carefully counted. We also made wonderful seascapes for our dolphin pictures.

In Chinese class this week we read a story about an elephant wrestling with a mouse. We created artwork for the tiger, painting him orange, and also made an elephant mask!

#### Vocabulary:

Here are the vocabulary words so far this term. You can look at them in their home language to help their understanding!

**English:** farm, horse, pig, sheep, cow, grass, sea, ocean, jellyfish, shark, fish, crab, octopus and dolphin.

Chinese: cat, dog, fish, rabbit, bird. jungle, tiger, crocodile, monkey and elephant.

#### What we will do next week:

Next week in English we will look in depth at where the animals they have learnt about live. We will practice sorting the animals into the correct Habitats.

In Chinese next week, we will learn about the monkey and the crocodile. We will create artwork, look at their characteristics and where they live.
