What we did this week:

The children settled back into the new classroom very well this week and they were able to continue with their routines!

We welcomed back Ms. Rachael, from her maternity leave, to the English classroom!

It was great to see you all during the Parent-Teacher conferences! We hope your meeting was informative and that all your queries were answered. If you still have questions or concerns please email your homeroom teacher.

This week we have started learning about our new UOI: Animals live in different places.

As well as learning the target vocabulary, the children will look at what they eat, stories and songs about those animals, and where they live.

In English, the children will look at which animals live in the sea and on the farm. We started by looking at the horse and the sheep on the farm. The children loved learning the new songs and singing/dancing them together!

In Chinese, the children will look at which animals live in the Jungle and in the household (pets)
This week the children started learning about the 'dog'. What he looks like and what he eats.

By the end of the unit, each child should be able to identify the animals by name and place them all into the correct habitats.

What we will do next week:

Next week in English we will look at more animals that live on the Farm (the Cow and the Pig) and create lots of artwork for them. We will read 'Where's woolly?' and play sorting games.

In Chinese next week, the children will learn about the cat and the fish. They will read a story and learn about what they eat and what they look like.
